This well-built home is in good condition overall and has been well maintained to date. Many systems have been updated or replaced to make the house more comfortable.

- Roofing The roof was covered with snow and could not be inspected.
 The roof coverings were installed in May 2023, with a typical life span of 20 25 years. When the weather permits, a full roof inspection is recommended.
- Exterior The exterior has been well maintained and is in good condition. Much of it is low maintenance and includes aluminum soffit, fascia, downspouts and eaves troughs.
- Structure The structure has performed well, with no evidence of significant movement.
- Electrical The 100-amp electrical service is suitable for a home of this size. The electrical system has been upgraded and includes several modern safety devices, such as circuit breakers and ground fault interrupters.
- Heating The heating system includes a ten year-old gas-fired highefficiency furnace, which has a typical life expectancy of fifteen to twenty years. Hot water radiant floor heating has been installed in the basement floors.
- Cooling The air conditioner is four years old, with a typical life expectancy of ten to fifteen years.
- **Plumbing** The main water supply pipe from the street to the house has been upgraded. This newer pipe will provide optimal water pressure.
- Interior The interior of the home has been well maintained.
